



Transition to Independent Living Allowance (TILA)

**Claims under the criteria of formal care**

This form is for the use of State and Territory Child Protection staff to verify the care status of young people claiming the Transition to Independent Living Allowance (TILA).<sup>1</sup> This information is required to verify the circumstances of young people claiming TILA under the criteria of Formal Care.<sup>2</sup>

1) Young person's name

2) Young person's date of birth

3) Is the young person **currently** the subject of a care and protection order? No  Yes  ▷ On what date will the young person's order expire?  ▷ **Go to Question 5**

4) Was the young person **previously** the subject of a care and protection order? No  ▷ **The young person is not eligible for TILA under the formal care provisions.** Yes  ▷ On what date did the young person's order expire?  ▷ **Go to Question 5**

5) Additional information — (if requested by the young person)

Express consent is required to release this information. The declaration at Section 2 of the TILA Referral Assessment Form provides the applicant the opportunity to give their written consent for child protection authorities to release the relevant information to verify their circumstances in regard to their TILA claim.
